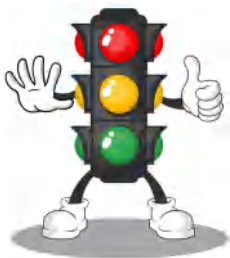
Message from Mr Green
