Welcome in Nursery

The following half term topic is “Emergency Emergency! ”. In this term we will explore the variety of roles that adults take in the pupil’s lives. We will discuss the roles and responsibilities of close kin family members which children will have some familiarities with and focus on other roles of people within the communities. In phonics our focus is oral blending and alliteration, children will try to identify couplets and will be introduced to CVC words. In maths we are ordering numbers and focus on counting. Also, we will sequence the days of the week and timings of the day such as morning, afternoon, and night. Our brand-new role play area themed as “Veterinary Surgery ” will support our children’s imagination and storytelling. In Science we will be discussing about changes in materials and describe the effects on different materials for example when cooked in the oven or get wet. In Technology we will be learning how to use talk buttons and torches within the story area.

We will be encouraging the children to read every day. Please listen to your children read at home or access Bug Club. Ask if you have any questions about this.

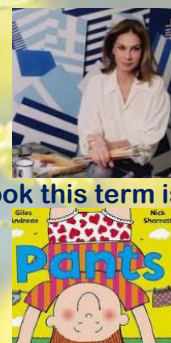
Outdoor learning

A Guide to using Tapestry



To view your child's learning journal

1. Login
2. Go to the 'children' tab (you will see your child's name only).
3. Click on your child's photo
4. Select 'view *Joe's* journal.'
5. Select the observation you wish to view.
6. Add a comment if you wish e.g. *well done, or Joe also took turns in a board game at home this weekend.*

To add your own observation at home....

To add notes....

- Click on 'obs' tab at top of screen.
- Click on 'add observation.'
- Type in information; title, date notes.

To add a photo.....

- Click on 'add media' to upload a photo.
- Click on 'add file'
- Click on 'start upload'

Finally...Click save!

Your child's key person will then be notified of your observation and use it to support your child's learning and progress.
