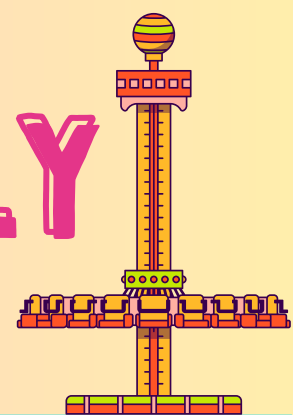

We have some exciting trips coming up and all trips have been added to Arbor.

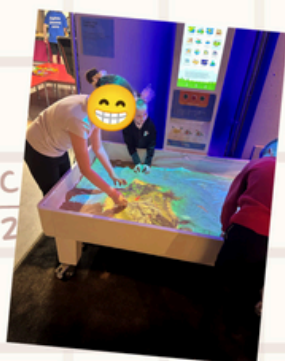
Payments for paid trips are to be paid via Arbor. To help with the costs, on some trips, you can make your payment in instalments.
